

BUL 5811: Managers and the Legal Environment

Course Description: Course focuses on the legal environment of the business. You will learn about the legal system, major legal issues facing the manager in a business corporation, and you will be introduced to ethics and law, agency, contracts, torts, product liability, employment law, and international transactions. You should become a more astute user of legal services and you should gain a more comprehensive view of the environment in which you do business. In addition to the substantive subject matter presented by the instructor and text, a variety of specific business law problems will be examined and analyzed through research projects. You will have an opportunity to explore law-related problems of particular interest to you, and you will be introduced to methods of updating your understanding of law.
