

BUL 6441: Business Ethics and Social Responsibility

Course Description: The course will examine the practical issues of managers in addressing ethical and moral problems in business. It will draw on a variety of materials and experiences as a basis for analyzing and evaluating the manager's and the firm's options and decisions. I encourage you to think critically and to develop an analytical framework for thinking about business ethical problems.

The course involves a fair amount of reading and writing. You are expected to attend every class, to have the materials in advance, and to be prepared to discuss them. Class preparation and attendance are critical to the success of the course. Each person makes a unique contribution that is missed when absent. Do not miss class unless it is urgent that you do so. If you must miss class, please account for your absence either before the class or as soon thereafter as practicable. I expect you to come to class having done all the reading and prepared to discuss it in class.
