PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING:

- All courses are 2 credits except for Professional Writing (1 credit) and Professional Communication (1 credit). The 2-credit courses meet for four contact hours per week over a 6-week period and much reading and work is required outside of class. Almost all courses have one group/team project and at least one examination. All course work and exams are contained in the module in which the course is offered.
- If the same course is listed twice (example: Professional Communication), you choose only one. It is the same course, but with different meeting times. You choose the time that fits best in your schedule and other course choices.
- **GatorNest** is an exciting and unique learning opportunity that will have you doing consulting work for real businesses. Each project lasts one term and is worth 2 credits. It appears on your UF transcript just like any other course and you receive a grade.
