

Jaclyn Freesman Selected to be UF Representative for the International Student Business Forum

Fisher School of Accounting student Jaclyn Freesman has been selected to travel to Athens, Greece in March 2011 to be the UF representative on the U.S. team for the International Student Business Forum (ISBF) hosted by Deloitte.

Each year, students from around 20 countries are selected to attend the event. Jaclyn was the only UF student selected out of a pool of nearly 200 applicants across the country (a total of 10 U.S. students were selected).

The ISBF is a unique leadership and career development forum for top talented students from around the world. During the event, participants work in cross-cultural teams to solve a complex business case that will develop their understanding of business practice and theory. They will pick up key skills such as cross-cultural teaming and leadership that will help them become a future leader of business. They will also have an opportunity to apply real-life, practical issues and see how they are solved from some of the best people in the business. This will be an interactive learning environment that will challenge and stimulate them in equal measure.
