As Chief Credit Officer, Marzol is responsible for credit research, credit portfolio management, policies and standards and counterparty risk management. He serves on Fannie Mae's Credit Committee and Risk Policy Committee and serves as a member of the Asset/Liability Committee. Fannie Mae's Strategy & Competitive Analysis team is responsible for Fannie Mae's corporate long-term strategy and supporting Fannie Mae's Senior Leadership Team.

**Past Experience:** Previously, Adolfo served as senior vice president of Single-Family business. In that role, he was responsible for product pricing, new product development, and the financial performance of our Credit Guaranty business. Adolfo began his career at Fannie Mae as senior vice president of capital markets, where he was responsible for the development and marketing of mortgage securities products, including Real Estate Mortgage Investment Conduits (REMICs). He also managed our brokering and lender funding services, which include our customer service trading desk and custodial services. Additionally, he managed our relationship with mortgage-backed securities investors.

Adolfo formerly served as executive vice president and chief financial officer for Chase Manhattan Mortgage Corporation. In that position, he was responsible for interest-rate risk management, long-term strategic planning for Chase's mortgage business strategy, and all financial accounting and business performance reporting associated with mortgage servicing, loan origination, and the mortgage investment portfolio.

Adolfo currently serves on the Board of the National Alliance to End Homelessness and the Board of Smithsonian Business Ventures.
