Huey Richardson currently resides in New York, NY with his wife Katherine. They were just married in July of this year and have no children. Mr. Richardson has lived in New York City since graduating with his MBA from Emory University in Atlanta, GA. in May of 2000.

Mr. Richardson currently works for Merrill Lynch as a Vice President on the Stock Loan Desk. He has held this position for the past eight months after rejoining the firm in January of this year. He was previously with Merrill Lynch for 6 years as a Listed Equities Associate. During this time he worked on the floor of the New York Stock Exchange where he facilitated and executed institutional client orders.

Prior to earning his MBA, Mr. Richardson was the owner and President of Richardson & Associates Contractors, Inc. (RAC) in Atlanta, GA. Before selling the company in 1998, he directed RAC to sales of \$1 million and joint ventures contracts of over \$12 million in 1997. Some of the company's major clients included Atlanta's Olympic Stadium, Starbucks Coffee and Doubletree Hotels.

Mr. Richardson was a first-round draft choice in the 1991 NFL Draft and spent several years in the National Football League, playing for the Pittsburgh Steelers (Outside Linebacker), Washington Redskins (Outside Linebacker), New York Jets (Defensive End), and Miami Dolphins (Defensive End). He was inducted into the Southeastern Conference (SEC) Hall of Fame in December 2001 and the University of Florida Athletic Hall of Fame in April 2003.
