Rebecca Patterson is Global Head of Foreign Exchange and Commodities for J.P. Morgan's private clients. In this role, she is responsible for developing foreign exchange and commodity investment strategies for the firm's high-net-worth clients around the globe. Rebecca is also a core member of the private bank's Investment Committee, helping to determine client portfolio allocations across asset classes.

Rebecca has been with J.P. Morgan since 1997. Most recently, she served as the senior global FX strategist, North America, for the J.P. Morgan Investment Bank. She has also held posts as head of emerging Asian FX research, based in Singapore, and was a member of the FX and Precious Metals strategy team in London. Rebecca was instrumental in the development of quantitative tools to help investors manage FX risks, and formulated the bank's views on FX markets worldwide.

Prior to joining J.P. Morgan, Rebecca worked as a journalist covering politics, economics and financial markets for Dow Jones, the Associated Press and the *St. Petersburg (Florida) Times*, in London, Rome, New York and Washington, DC. She is a frequent guest speaker on CNBC and is quoted regularly in the media.

Rebecca has a M.A. with high honors from Johns Hopkins University's School of Advanced International Studies in international economics and politics and holds an M.B.A. from New York University's Stern School of Business. She also received her B.S. with honors in journalism from the University of Florida.
