William J. Alcorn, Jr. recently retired as Senior Vice President, Controller and Chief Purchasing Officer of JCPenney Company. In that assignment, Bill was responsible for all financial reporting and transaction processing activities for the JCPenney Company. In 1993, Bill became Vice President and Director of Credit, a three-year assignment.

He is a member of the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants, the Texas Society of Certified Public Accountants and the Financial Executives International.
