

Florida MBA Makes U.S. News & World Report's Top 50 MBA Programs List

The University of Florida was named #41 among the world's best MBA programs in the April 3 issue of *U.S. News & World Report* magazine. Among public schools, Florida is ranked #20 overall.

The Florida MBA is one of only a few select programs that were ranked among the Top 25 in three or more of the core specialty categories (accounting, finance and marketing), based on the peer assessment of our world-class faculty:

Specialty Rankings Overall:

- #14 in Marketing
- #14 in Accounting (tie)
- #24 in Finance (tie)

Among Publics:

- #5 in Marketing
- #7 in Accounting
- #9 in Finance



Florida MBA students also had some of the highest admissions statistics in the country, with an average GMAT score of 674, placing UF in the Top 20 nationally (#19). And, again this year, UF was more selective than the previous year (one of only 12 schools), reflecting the collective effort and energies focused on continual improvement in all areas by the Florida MBA program.
