

Highlights of Forbes 2005 Best Business Schools Rankings

The University of Florida was named among the Top 50 in the *Forbes* 2005 Best Business Schools rankings. Rankings are based on the return on investment received by graduates of the Class of 2000.

Surveys were sent to 25,000 alumni of 111 MBA programs worldwide and results are based on comparisons of post-MBA (three of the first five years) compensation with opportunity cost salaries in previous jobs for the 24% who responded.

Salary figures were adjusted to account for cost-of-living expenses and earnings gains discounted, using a rate tied to money market yields.
