

You've decided to study abroad on the [UF in London program](#) ... so what's next?

- Step 1: Meet with the Warrington College of Business Administration
 - Call the School of Business at 352-273-0165 to schedule an appointment with Lucy DiLeo, Joe Rojo or Jason Ward to discuss program requirements and fill out the academic advising form and have your photo taken.
- Step 2: Apply online with the University of Florida International Center (UFIC)
 - Go to <http://www.abroad.ufic.ufl.edu/> and click on "Programs."
 - Search for your study abroad program:
 - UF in London – Business/Internship
 - Select your program and click "Apply Now."
 - Login using your **GatorLink** username and password.
 - Select the desired term and click "Apply."
 - Fill out the Application Questionnaires and complete all of the Signature Documents.
 - Drop off the advising form with a deposit of \$250 (checks and money orders are accepted) to the UF International Center, located in 170 HUB, within **SEVEN** days of starting the application!
- Step 3: Ensure your passport is valid
 - If you do not have a valid passport, go to <http://travel.state.gov/passport/> and follow the appropriate steps to either apply for or renew your U.S. Passport.
 - Your passport must not expire within six months of your expected **return date**.
- Step 4: Apply for scholarships
 - Apply for a WCBA scholarship by filling out the forms found on the WCBA website: <http://www.warrington.ufl.edu/sb/advising/scholarships.asp>.
 - **School of Business Scholarship Deadlines:** Spring: October 1 & Summer/ Fall: March 1
 - Apply for a scholarship through the UF International Center by visiting <http://www.abroad.ufic.ufl.edu> and selecting "Planning to Study Abroad" and clicking the link at "Financial Aid or Scholarships."
 - **UFIC Scholarship Deadlines:** Spring: end of September, Summer: beginning of February, & Fall: mid-March.
 - Our partner, the Foundation for International Education (FIE), offers a scholarship for the fall and spring semester. On the web: http://www.fie.org.uk/student_center/admissions/scholarships/
- Step 5: Complete the following checklist for your program:
 - The Foundation for International Education (FIE) requires an application form. Return completed form to us in 133 Bryan Hall. On the web: http://warrington.ufl.edu/sb/docs/intl_NonUF_FIEAppliation.pdf
 - Have your photo taken by Joe Rojo or Lucy DiLeo in 133 Bryan Hall for FIE.
 - Email a scanned copy of your passport and a copy of your flight itinerary to Lucy DiLeo at lucy.dileo@warrington.ufl.edu
 - Apply online for a PicCell Wireless phone. <http://www.piccellwireless.com/warrington>
 - **If you are participating in an internship, you must apply for a visa in consultation with the UFIC.** See the FIE website: http://www.fie.org.uk/student_center/london_students/visa_information/
 - Have your Laptop checked by the TAC. Schedule an appointment by calling 352.273.0248.
 - Attend the **MANDATORY** PreDeparture session for your program scheduled during the semester before the program starts (fall semester sessions are held in the late spring).
