

## Transfer Admission Requirements for the Online Business Program

Admission requirements for the Online Business Program include:

- 1) Florida residency.
- 2) Completion of an Associate of Arts (AA) degree or 60 semester hours of transferable credit.
- 3) Completion of the university's foreign language requirement, which calls for two years of the same language in high school or a minimum of 8 credit hours in college. Equivalent testing credit through AP, IB, CLEP, or SAT2 exams is also acceptable.
- 4) No institutional GPA under 2.0, unless transferred in as part of an AA degree.
- 5) Completion of seven preprofessional business courses with at least a 2.5 GPA *on all attempts*:
  - ECO2013 Macroeconomics
  - ECO2023 Microeconomics
  - MAC2233 Survey of Calculus 1
  - STA2023 Introduction to Statistics
  - ACG2021 Financial Accounting (or ACG2001 and ACG2011)
  - ACG2071 Managerial Accounting
  - CGS1100 Computer Applications (course number varies)

### IMPORTANT NOTES:

- 1) Students must have grades earned in at least three of the above seven preprofessional courses, before an admission decision will be made. Qualified applicants in this situation will be admitted to the Online Business Program with the stipulation that they complete remaining requirements prior to UF enrollment.
- 2) Once a grade of 'C' has been achieved in a preprofessional course, no further attempts of the course or its equivalents will be calculated into the preprofessional GPA.
- 3) Students who have completed any preprofessional coursework outside of the Florida public system must have their coursework reviewed for equivalency to UF's preprofessional requirements. A Preprofessional Course Equivalence Request Form must be completed for every course not already reviewed and deemed equivalent by the WCBA. - 4) Students transferring from out-of-state or private institutions who have not had an opportunity to take or exempt themselves from the College Level Academic Skills Test (CLAST) may be admitted with the stipulation that they satisfy this requirement during their first term of UF enrollment.
- 5) Students who have previously attended UF in campus-based majors are ineligible for the Online Business Program.
