

WCBA Scholarship List

Stanley S. Barchan, Jr. Scholarship: Stanley S. Barchan, Jr., longtime California resident and a native of Jacksonville, FL, received his BSBA and MA degrees from the University of Florida where he was a member of the Florida Blue Key and Phi Gamma Delta Fraternity. This non-endowed scholarship will be used to award scholarships to business students on the basis of need.

H.A. "Buddy" Bishop, Jr. Scholarship: The income from an endowment is available annually to provide scholarships for worthy students in any business major. Awards are based on academic achievement or financial need.

Business Alumni Scholarship: This scholarship is awarded in variable amounts. Selection is based on academic achievement or financial need.

Business Undergraduate Scholarship: Scholarship support students in the Warrington College of Business Administration who decide to study abroad on a WCBA business program.

Matthew P. Brunson Memorial Scholarship: Scholarships in varying amounts are awarded annually to outstanding business undergraduate students. Selection is based on merit and academic achievement.

Mr. and Mrs. George W. Etheridge Scholarship: This scholarship is awarded to students studying abroad.

Sam Calhoun Fleming Scholarship: Scholarships are awarded annually from the income of an endowment fund established by the Panama Machinery & Supply Co. along with seven Fleming family members to honor prominent Panama City resident Sam Calhoun Fleming. Selection is based on academic achievement and financial need. Preferably students from several counties in Florida, primarily in the panhandle.

Donald R. Johnson Memorial Scholarship: This memorial scholarship is funded by an endowment established by Johnson family members and business associates of Forms Manufacturers Equipment, Inc. Eligibility is limited to Management majors and recipients are selected based on academic achievement or financial need.

Addam Kellough Memorial Scholarship: This fund supports merit scholarships for students in their junior year (3BA) in the business college with a GPA of 3.5 or higher. The family strongly prefers that the recipients are "well-rounded students" who avoid motorcycles. Applicants will be required to submit a 2-page, double spaced, essay demonstrating: academic and non-academic interests, avoidance of riding motorcycles, leadership skills and involvement in community service

William C. McElmurray Scholarship: This scholarship supports undergraduate business students based on need and merit. Students from the Tampa area will be given priority in the selection process.

John B. McFerrin Scholarship: Scholarships are awarded annually from the income of an endowment fund established by friends and former students of Dr. McFerrin, retired professor of Finance and Associate Dean of the College. Selection is based on academic achievement and financial need.

Ponsoldt Family Education Scholarship: A scholarship to any Business major. Preference given to a student suffering temporary financial setback (death of parent, natural disaster, etc.) and from Martin, St. Lucie, Palm Beach & Dade counties.

Todd C. Prosser Memorial Scholarship: This memorial scholarship, in the amount of \$500 is funded by an endowment established by the Prosser family for their son, Todd. Selection is based on Business students who demonstrate academic excellence with preference to students graduating from high schools in Marion, Alachua or Lake County.

Bertha Ring Memorial Scholarship: Students studying abroad who are majoring in Business Administration with course concentration in Human Resource Management.

Robert L. Rose Scholarship Fund: A scholarship is awarded to finance majors who demonstrate academic excellence. Qualified applicants must be U.S. residents.

Brent Schlueter Memorial Scholarship: This memorial scholarship is funded by an endowment established by the Schleuter family for their son, Brent. Selection is based on business students who show academic achievement or financial need; preference can be given to members of the Delta Sigma Pi business fraternity or finance majors.

Lauren Weiss Memorial Scholarship: The fund was established in 2007 in memory of Lauren Michelle Weiss. Lauren, born June 18, 1982, passed away in 2002 in a car accident traveling home to Coral Springs, FL during Spring Break. Scholarship is to support study abroad for undergraduate students in the Warrington College of Business Administration.

Adolph Wohlgemuth Scholarship Fund: Adolph "Al" Wohlgemuth, a longtime resident of Miami, worked in real estate and improved many properties he purchased in minority neighborhoods. In his desire to give something back to the community that gave him so much, Wohlgemuth provided funding to the University of Florida for an endowment to support scholarships for students.

N. Young Student Exchange: The scholarship is for undergraduate students in the Warrington College of Business Administration; based on academic performance. The fund supports annual scholarship awards for needy students and for outstanding student assistants in the business college.
