Accounting students who will leave UF with a Bachelor of Science degree in Accounting (BSAc) and do not seek admission to the Master of Accounting degree (MAcc) at UF, may complete TAX 4001 – Introduction to Federal Income Tax instead of TAX5025 – Federal Income Tax 1 and TAX5027 – Federal Income Tax 2. Similarly, these students may also complete ACG 4632 – Introduction to Auditing instead of ACG5637 – Auditing 1 and ACG 5647 – Auditing 2.

**What’s the difference between the 4000 level and the 5000 level of the courses?**

The 4000 level courses are textbook based and focus on the essential elements of the subject matter. The 5000 level courses provide a broader conceptually-oriented view of the subject matter to be developed further in the MAcc.

**May I complete the 4000 level courses if I am in the 3/2 program?**

No. All 3/2 students must complete the 5000-level version of the courses.

**May I complete the 4000 level courses if I am applying for admission to the Traditional Master of Accounting program (4/1 program) at UF?**

No. The MAcc program requires students complete the 5000 level version of the courses. Students who apply to the 4/1 MAcc without having completed the 5000 level of the courses will be denied admission.

**Will other Master of Accounting programs accept the 4000 level versions of the courses?**

Acceptance of the 4000 level version of the courses is unknown. Check with the admissions office of the program you are seeking admission.

**Will the 4000 level of the courses accrue credit for the CPA exam?**

In the State of Florida both 4000 level courses count towards the 36 credit hour accounting requirement. Acceptance in other jurisdictions is not known.

**What semester are the 4000 level courses offered?**

The 4000 level courses are only available during the spring semester.

**How do I get in enrolled in the 4000 level courses offered in spring?**

You cannot register for the course(s) using ONE.UF. **Come in to the office during walk-in office hours** and our advisers will help you register for the course. For walk in hours availability visit:
