- Awards are distributed <u>during the second week of the Fall 2024 semester</u> after verification of enrollment for the Fall 2024 term.
- Note a minimum 3.3 overall and upper-division accounting GPA has historically been the approximate minimum required for serious consideration for awards, but GPA's of award recipients may vary from year to year.
