- This application is for currently enrolled students of the University of Florida who will enter their fifth year of studies during the Fall 2024 semester as a Master of Accounting student (and be capable of completing their MAcc degree by August 2025).

- **The deadline to submit this application is February 1, 2024.**
- The awards range in value from \$2,500 to \$4,000. Finalists for awards must attend our annual spring awards banquet where the award winners will be announced.
- Awards are distributed during the second week of the Fall 2024 semester after verification of enrollment for the Fall 2024 term.
- Note a minimum 3.3 overall and upper-division accounting GPA has historically been the approximate minimum required for serious consideration for awards, but GPA's of award recipients may vary from year to year.
