

Junior Scholarship Program

The RSM Junior Scholarship program is supported by the RSM US Foundation to recognize and reward Fisher School of Accounting juniors who have distinguished themselves after the completion of all required 3000 level accounting courses. The winners of these \$2,500 scholarships will be selected by the Fisher School of Accounting faculty Awards Committee. Winners will be announced, and scholarship proceeds will be disbursed early 2025. In making its decisions, the Committee will use a holistic approach and consider all attributes it deems relevant selecting scholarship recipients.

- At the end of Spring 2025 drop/add, must be registered to complete both ACG 4111 and ACG 4341 no later than Spring 2025. Must not yet have enrolled in ACG 4632, TAX 4001, ACG 5637, ACG 5647, TAX 5025, or TAX 5027.
- Applicants must be US citizens and those entitled to reside permanently in the US.
- Applicants will be invited to a social event, hosted by RSM, where the scholarship recipients will be announced. Attendance at this event is required to be awarded the scholarship. Additional details to come.
