

Rich Lutz reported that the Strategic Planning team consists of about thirty faculty and staff and they have been meeting every other Friday. He discussed the planning process and stated the Committee is continuing to gather information from different external and internal groups for suggestions on what to prioritize. Dr. Lutz presented a draft document of the mission statement and then some discussion took place. Dr. Lutz stated that these forces will help us to make sure we are working in a realistic context. He said this is basically a progress report at this time.

3. P&T COMMITTEE REPORT

Henry Tosi presented several items for discussion regarding proposed changes in CBA Tenure and Promotion Review Procedures. The issues discussed were: 1) Start process in late spring rather than fall; 2) Modifying the information request for packets to include syllabi and exams; 3) Reading Committees and Reading Committee Reports; 4) Change to appointment calendar for Promotion and Tenure Calendar. Much discussion took place. At this point it was decided that these changes will be discussed again and may need action in the future.

4. Deans Report

Dean Kraft reported that the College is in the quite phase of the Capital Campaign and will formally start around July 1. He stated that the focus of this campaign is more program related. The goal for the College will be around \$50 million. The faculty were encouraged to provide feedback.






