

The Undergraduate Committee met six times during the 2008-2009 academic year: September 19th, October 10th, November 14th, January 26th, March 23rd, and April 13th. The following are the highlights of the committee's work. Details of the following highlights can be read in the attached minutes of the individual meetings.

Curriculum

ISOM Minor: A 16-credit minor in Information Systems and Operations Management was approved.

Business Minor: The requirements for the business minor were increased from five courses to six.

International Law Course: Approved new course: BUL 4261 International Business Law

Changes in ECO 2013 and ECO2023: Approved an increase in the scope and content for ECO 2013 and ECO 2023. As a result, the credits for each course were increased from three to four.

Enhanced Degree Requirements: Added a new requirement for the BSBA and BABA program (2009-2010 catalog year). An internship of 150 hours or a study abroad experience of at least six weeks.

Prerequisite Changes for MAN 3025 and MAR 3023: AEB 2014 was added as an acceptable prerequisite for MAN 3025 and MAR 3023.

Assurance of Learning

Overall Strategy: The assurance of learning plan for the BSBA and BABA degrees was finalized with significant data being collected in Fall 2008 and Spring 2009. The assurance of learning plans are attached.

ETS Data: The first set of data for the ETS Major Field Test in Business was discussed. Students were found to be consistently scoring among the top ten percent in the nation. A summary of the Spring 2009 data is attached.
