GENERAL INFORMATION

I. GENERAL PROCEDURES

- A. The Summer Research Award Program is designed to enhance the skills and productivity of the faculty participant.
- B. All recipients are required to report the results of their Summer 2022 research to the supporting unit (with a copy to Senior Associate Dean's office) by the end of January 2023.
- C. A written proposal must be submitted to the unit offering the support. The proposal must conform to the guidelines established by the WCB Faculty Research Committee or the offering unit. The guidelines and appropriate forms for College support are available at <https://warrington.ufl.edu/faculty-and-staff/> . The submission deadline date is **February 18, 2022**.

II. SOURCE SPECIFIC INFORMATION AND PROCEDURE

 - 1. Commitment Research Awards. Several faculty will receive summer support as a result of various commitments including hiring awards. Guidelines and proposal application are available at <https://warrington.ufl.edu/faculty-and-staff/>. A proposal is required for all Commitment Research Awards as well as a post-activity report.
 - 2. Competitive Research Awards. The College expects to offer a number of competitive research awards for Summer 2022. The number of awards, which depends on current budgetary outcomes and the number of qualified applicants, will be announced at award date. Tenured, non-tenure track and clinical faculty are eligible to apply. Guidelines and proposal application are available at <https://warrington.ufl.edu/faculty-and-staff/> . A proposal is required for all Competitive Research Awards as well as a post-activity report.
 - 3. Award Date and Amount: All awards will be paid in a lump sum in June. The exact date and award amount will be specified with the award notification.
