Description

Requirements

In order to declare the English Area of Specialization, students must first formally declare the English Minor.

Students are required to have a minimum of five classes totaling 15 hours from any of the 3000-4000 level courses listed below and maintain a minimum 2.0 Area of Specialization GPA. Be sure to check course prerequisite requirements.

Any 3000/4000-level [AML](#), [CRW](#), [ENC \(ENC 3310, 3312, 3250, 3414, 4212, 4260\)](#), [ENG](#), [ENL](#), [LIT](#), excluding 4905 courses. The majority of the department's upper-division courses are variable or rotating topics courses, many of which can be repeated for credit given a change in topic. The only way to discover what the actual course topics will be in a specific semester is to consult the department's course descriptions, which explain topics and approaches, and generally give some idea of the texts and assignments. These descriptions are usually posted online three-to-four weeks before advance registration so that students have ample time to consult them before registering.
