

Bachelor of Arts in Business Administration **Area of Specialization: *Florida Teaching (PTT)***

Description

The area of specialization in Florida Teaching is appropriate for students who wish to teach in Florida. If students choose to complete the minor in this area, it is an alternative certification program, specifically a Professional Training Option (PTO), meant to prepare students for temporary teacher certification in Florida. Professional teacher certification is attainable after one year of successful teaching in a Florida public school. Please see the [FLDOE](#) for information about certification. Requirements

In order to pursue this area of specialization, students must have applied for the Florida Teaching minor and must have a 2.5 overall GPA. Students are required to have a minimum of four classes totaling 12 hours from courses listed below (students have a minimum 2.5 Area of Specialization GPA) to complete the area of specialization. In order to complete the minor, one course in each of the following categories must be completed. Be sure to check course prerequisite requirements.
